1. Executive Summary

EMIS JBC refers to the Education Management Information System of Jana Bhawana Campus which keeps record of different activities like year wise Enrollment status, Dropouts ratio, Examination status as well as it keeps record of graduates from the campus. It is simply an information system for data collection, storage, integration, analysis and dissemination. To make EMIS system effective in Jana Bhawana Campus, it has installed integrated software to establish connectivity among units within and has an EMIS personnel who updates the necessary information related to the campus education system. It provides information to all users to enable them to conduct different tasks more efficiently, it also enables decision-makers to take better decisions and justify them based on created information, and it also enables planning and policy development. Recently, EMIS Jana Bhawana has a software called Era soft which helps to strengthen the EMIS of the campus.

1. Number of Students

In the year 2077, the total number of students who were enrolled in Jana Bhawana Campus in Bachelor level was 699 and 56 in Master level. Out of the total students enrolled in Bachelor level 68.99% were girls and 31.90% were boys. Likewise, in Master Level 67.85% were girls and 32.14% were boys.

2. Enrollment and drop outs

i. Enrollment 2077

In 2077, there were altogether 84,131,48 and 35 students enrolled in BBS, BA, B.Ed. and MBS respectively. The total number of students perusing turned out to be 252 in BBS, 303 in BA, 144 in B.Ed and 56 in Master's Level .In BBS there were 219 male and 480 were female. Similarly, In BA there were 106 Male and 195 female and In B.Ed there were 16 male and 128 female. Likewise, 21 were enrolled in Masters level where 9 were male and 12 students were female.

The Students in Jana Bhawana Campus were enrolled in 2076 in Bachelors and Masters level are shows in the following table according to different perspectives.

ii. Drop out 2077

The dropout ratio of the students in Bachelor's level is higher than that of Master's level. In Bachelor's level the total drop outs number is 107 whereas in Master's level there was no dropouts. In total, 48 students dropped out in BBS, 38 students dropped out in BA, 14 dropped out in B.Ed. 41 Male and 66 female students dropped out in Bachelor's Level. The dropped out ratio of female is higher than male students'. The data shows that the drop outs ratio is not very high however, this should be minimized more. Few students do not continue their education due to financial problem and they have a trend of engaging in different jobs so the college can plan some effective ways out to address these problems.
